<u>LUKE 3:11 UNTIL MATTHEW 6:33, INC.</u> General Non-Fellowship Letter to the Unsaved

Dear to whom it may concern,

Get saved.

Before you hear/read any other word from me, hear that. It is the MOST important decision you could ever make in this realm. My heart goes out to you because though I'm certain beyond a shadow of a doubt that you have heard that before from some person who said they were a Christian, I am almost equally certain that that person was walking in rebellion to what that title truly means. Because, if they weren't, you and most of the people who are knowingly categorized as the people this letter is addressed to would be saved. If I could borrow the words of Gandhi (NOT a Christian), "I suppose if Christians truly acted like Christ, I myself would be one...".

I lament for you. Especially the young. You were born into a culture and society where hypocritical "Christianity" is so prevalent, real ones seem like crazy cultist weirdos or are a fairy tale because you've never met one.

I lament for you. Because you live in a world full of confusion and the people who have the biggest signs saying they've found the answers are nine times out of ten, also the biggest liars, crooks and con-artists. I still remember my confusion for the brief time I walked away from God when the "pastor" of the Baptist church I used to attend was removed from position for getting one of my high school classmates pregnant.

I lament for you. Because though you are still destined to stand in front of the same eternal, faithful, and righteous Judge who will not pardon your choice to reject Him because the people that duct-taped His name across their buildings, cars, and homes looked more like the father of lies than the Father of the heavenly lights, you have to make a decision for Christ that would have been a lot easier to make and a lot more pleasant to endure than the trials that await those of you who repent and find hope before it is all lost.

That being said, it doesn't mean that you don't have a choice to make. It doesn't mean that the Most High God isn't really real and the best choice you could choose. It just means that finding Him is much harder than the hypocritical churches make it seem. But if you are willing to seek, regardless of the cost, you will find. If you will ask, regardless of what the others who hear your words say and do to try to dissuade you from receiving the answer, Truth will be given to you.

However, I will warn you of the same problem I faced in the latter years of our church's 1st homeless mission. Getting saved and finding THE Church among all this confusion are two different steps along the same path. I don't even know if you are willing to give Jesus another chance, but if you do, give Him a chance while seeking Him with a group of believers who will do so earnestly, without

hypocrisy or a desire to use you for their own benefit. I am 100% certain that we are one such group. I am also 100% certain that there are other groups like us that will at one point unite according to prophecy and scripture, but where those other groups are, I cannot tell you as I've had the opportunity to travel all over the world in service to the King of kings, and I can count on one hand the number of REAL Church fellowships that wish to follow Christ with everything they have, no limitations and no fakery, whatever the cost...

I urge you, if not us, find a REAL Church fellowship and get in relationship with the Most High through His Son. I will give you some help in finding them if we aren't your go to:

- If the "church" you want to attend does not have an observable track record of earnestly trying to repent into one body that stands on the Word of God ALONE with every other "church" in walking distance from them at the time this message goes out, they aren't the real Church. Why? Because the Word they want to preach down your throat, they don't follow themselves.
- If the "church" you want to attend is a part of a "denomination" and they have been a part of that "denomination" for any length of time without bumping heads with the tenets of the "denomination" vs. the tenets of the Bible (and siding with the Bible, even if it means they lose their denominational support), they aren't the real Church. Why? Because the word denomination itself is an explicitly unbiblical term. (If you choose to walk with us, either I or your overseer will explain that to you if you so desire)
- If the "church" you want to attend has a "good time" more than a challenge for you to repent more, or the pastor's known for being "funny" more than "convicting", or the sermons validate you (aim to make you feel "loved", "accepted", etc.) more so than pricking you in your soul and inflaming you to repentance and spiritual growth, they aren't the real Church. That's like going to the gym to lose weight and they have the walls lined with fun house mirrors to make you look skinnier than you actually are.

These are just a few examples, but you can skip the potential gamble of walking into a social club with Jesus plastered on the front sign by joining us as we walk closer and closer towards the image of Christ. We're not an entertainment resort with a 5-star hotel on the beach and a laser light show, we don't have a day care for your kids, we will not spare your feelings or your pride because we truly care about your soul. Let me ask you this, which soldier do you to be, the one that has all the training needed to survive the fight or the one who had the most fun in basic training and comes back from the war in a box? The fight is unavoidable either way. If you want to survive the fight, put your feelings and pride to the side. The abrasive pain of un-sugared Truth is the sandpaper that makes for a sharp sword...

Again, get saved. Hear and do that if you don't do anything else.

Yes, witchcraft is real. Yes, you can use it to get what you want in certain moments under certain circumstances. But the price you will pay for it is one you truly can't afford and at the end of the day you will find that what you want, can make you cry...

Yes, sorcery is all around us. People don't even realize how **legally** prevalent it is, but it too will fall short of your hopes and expectations that only the Most High can fulfill anyway.

I will conclude with this. Satan only seems like a good option when God is made to look like a fool. And though Satan could never in his wildest fantasies, hope to do such a thing to the Most High directly, he has worked VERY hard to make the people who claim His Name make Him look like one. And that's Christianity's fault, but don't blame Christ for that. Don't get it twisted. He doesn't make "Christians", He makes disciples. The world is the place that gets caught up in titles...
